INSTRUCTOR'S PROFILE	Sang Hoon Youm is currently an Associate Professor in the Department of Architecture and Architectural Engineering at Yonsei University. He graduated from Seoul National University and Columbia University in NY and leads the CAT Architecture & Urban Design Lab at Yonsei University. He explores the interface between cities and architecture, aiming to create environments that blend advanced technology with historical beauty. Also, as a professor at YARD (Yonsei Architecture Research and Design) group, he links education, research, and practice, participating in various public architecture and the city explores the evolving role of architects in the urban environment. His designs and research have been showcased at prestigious venues, including the National Museum of Modern and Contemporary Art Seoul and MoMA New York. Professor Youm also curated the Guest Cities Exhibition at the 4th Seoul Biennale of Architecture and Urbanism, and he has received various recognition, including the Korean Institute of Architects Award.
